

ERASMUS+ KA3: Working Group on Cross Sectorial Partnerships

On 23 June 2020, the Working Group on Cross Sectorial Partnerships of the Erasmus+ KA3 – Support for Policy Reform Civil Society Cooperation in the field of Youth had a statutory online meeting. Partners from Germany, Netherlands, Serbia, Ireland and Romania discussed why cross-sectorial partnerships are important in youth work across Europe and presented concrete examples how this works in their context. A special focus was put on the EU policy initiatives in the areas affecting youth: the EU Youth Dialogue, as well as European Youth Goals were analysed from the point of view of cross-sectorial collaboration.

The group will further collect the examples of good practice linked to the European Youth Goals, as well as give recommendations to raise the awareness of the importance of cross-sectorial partnerships. Also, it will map EU policy initiatives focussed on strengthening cross-sectorial partnerships on different levels. The next meeting is planned in November 2020.
